Barratt Impulsiveness Scale. The BIS-11 is a 30-item questionnaire and is designed to assess three separable dispositions: (1) attentional impulsiveness, defined as the (in-)ability to concentrate or focus attention, (2) motor impulsiveness, or the tendency to act without thinking, and (3) nonplanning impulsiveness, or the lack of future planning and forethought.

Complexity of scoring limits its use for assessment of pain at point of care: SF-36 BPS: A 2-item bodily pain scale that measures pain intensity and pain interference with normal activities. The SF-36 BP is 1 of the 8 SF-36 subscales: Self-administered, computer-administered, or interviewer-administered (in-person or by telephone)

The Delis-Kaplan Executive Function System (D-KEFS) is a neuropsychological test used to measure a variety of verbal and nonverbal executive functions for both children and adults (ages 8–89 years). This assessment was developed over the span of a decade by Dean Delis, Edith Kaplan, and Joel Kramer, and it was published in 2001. The D-KEFS comprises nine tests that were designed to stand alone.
