Skin Changes at Life's End (SCALE) is a concept that was introduced in 2009 to describe a group of unusual wounds that can occur at the end of life. 1 These wounds may present as classic pressure ulcers, deep tissue injury, unavoidable pressure injury, ischemic wounds, mottling, or tumors—essentially a whole range of wound types that appear in people who are in the dying process.

How can you decide it really was unavoidable? Defining Unavoidable Pressure Ulcers. One of the best sources for definitions is surprisingly the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). In the Minimum Data Set (MDS) instructions and surveyor guidelines there are very specific definitions for everything from wound types and stages to exudate.

Defining Avoidable and Unavoidable Pressure Ulcers

•Use a standardized data collection and documentation forms that list the significant skin and wound features at baseline and that will be tracked over the course of care •Information collection easier, better organized, more consistent when collected on form •Use of standardized forms ensures that important information is not lost
